


Atlanta Capital Focused Growth Fund

A focused approach to quality growth stock investing

The Fund: The Fund emphasizes quality, large-cap stocks with sustainable earnings growth potential. A conviction-weighted portfolio is created where stock selection will drive performance.

The Approach: The Fund uses rigorous, bottom-up fundamental analysis to seek out companies that we believe may generate above average sustainable earnings growth. These companies have historically been leaders in their industries, possessed high margins, generated high returns and maintained strong balance sheets.

The Features: Management believes a portfolio of only 20-35 stocks is best positioned to capture the longterm economic value of compounding earners and secular growth business models. Stocks are added to the Fund based on factors including the relative attractiveness of the risk/reward profile; earnings consistency; and expected sustainability and rate of earnings growth.



DEFINITIONS: Alpha measures risk-adjusted performance, showing excess return delivered at the same risk level as the benchmark. The **Average market capitalization** of the companies that have issued the common stocks owned by a Fund. Market Cap is determined by multiplying the price of a share of a company's common stock by the number of shares outstanding. **Beta** is a measure of the relative volatility of a security or portfolio to the market's upward or downward movements. **Number of holdings** provided are a typical range, not a maximum number. The portfolio may exceed this from time to time due to market conditions and outstanding trades. **R squared** measures how well an investment's returns correlate to an index. An R squared of 1.00 means the portfolio performance is 100% correlated to the index's, whereas a low r-squared means that the portfolio performance is less correlated to the index's. **Sharpe ratio** is a risk-adjusted measure calculated as the ratio of excess return to standard deviation. **Standard deviation** measures how widely individual performance returns, within a performance series, are dispersed from the average or mean value.

INDEX INFORMATION: The Russell 1000° Growth Index measures the performance of the large-cap growth segment of the U.S. equity universe. It includes those Russell 1000° Index companies with higher price-to-book ratios and higher forecasted growth values. The Russell 1000° Index is an index of approximately 1,000 of the largest U.S. companies based on a combination of market capitalization and current index membership.
