

Eaton Vance AMT-Free Municipal Income Fund

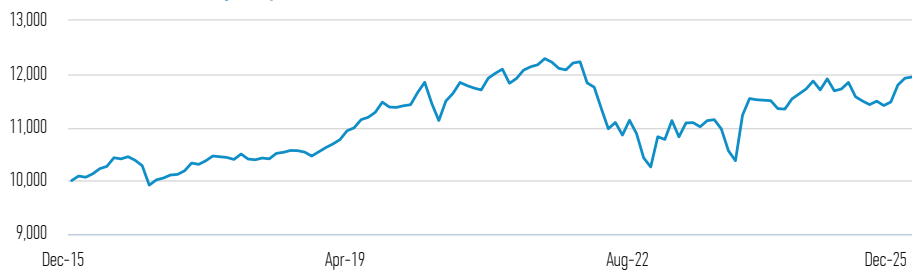
A diversified, credit-focused approach to municipal bond investing—without exposure to the Alternative Minimum Tax.

The Fund: This offering provides exposure to the municipal bond market, seeking to provide Fund shareholders with current income exempt from regular federal income tax. Fund investments span municipal sectors, states and credit tiers, with allocations directed by veteran manager, Cynthia Clemson, since 2005.

The Approach: The Fund's active management draws upon the expertise of Eaton Vance's municipal bond team, among America's largest and most experienced municipal bond managers. The investment team applies Eaton Vance's credit research process, while implementing a relative-value trading approach to municipal investing.

The Features: Eaton Vance's decades of municipal market experience informs the Fund's strategy. Invests in longer-maturity bonds than many peers, which may provide higher levels of tax-exempt income and greater price volatility. Relative-value trading may add to performance, while ongoing credit monitoring helps mitigate risk.

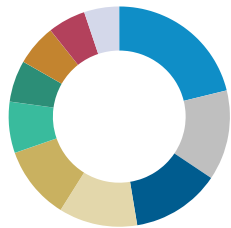

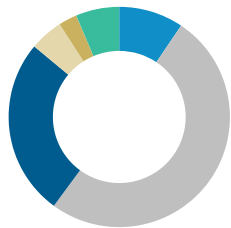

Ratings are based on Moody's, S&P or Fitch, as applicable. If securities are rated differently by the ratings agencies, the highest rating is applied. Ratings, which are subject to change, apply to the creditworthiness of the issuers of the underlying securities and not to the Fund or its shares. Credit ratings measure the quality of a bond based on the issuer's creditworthiness, with ratings ranging from AAA, being the highest, to D, being the lowest based on S&P's measures. Ratings of BBB or higher by S&P or Fitch (Baa or higher by Moody's) are considered to be investment-grade quality. Credit ratings are based largely on the ratings agency's analysis at the time of rating. The rating assigned to any particular security is not necessarily a reflection of the issuer's current financial condition and does not necessarily reflect its assessment of the volatility of a security's market value or of the liquidity of an investment in the security. Holdings designated as "Not Rated" are not rated by the national ratings agencies stated above.

DEFINITIONS: **Average duration** is a measure of the sensitivity of the price (the value of principal) of a fixed income investment to a change in interest rates. Duration is expressed as a number of years. Rising interest rates mean falling bond prices, while declining interest rates mean rising bond prices. **Average effective maturity** is the weighted average of the maturities of the underlying bonds accounting for any bonds that are callable. A bond's **average price** is calculated by adding its face value to the price paid for it and dividing the sum by two. The average price is sometimes used in determining a bond's yield to maturity where the average price replaces the purchase price in the yield to maturity calculation. **Number of holdings** provided are a typical range, not a maximum number. The portfolio may exceed this from time to time due to market conditions and outstanding trades. **SEC 30-day yield** is a measure of the income generated by the portfolio's underlying asset over the trailing 30 days, relative to the asset base of the portfolio itself.

INDEX INFORMATION: The **Bloomberg U.S. Municipal Bond Index** covers the USD-denominated long-term tax exempt bond market.
