Objective

The Fund's investment objective is to provide a high level of after-tax total return.

Fund Highlights

- The Fund invests primarily in global dividend-paying common and preferred stocks and seeks to distribute a high level of dividend income that qualifies for favorable federal income tax treatment.
- The Fund employs a value investment style and seeks to invest in dividend-paying common stocks that have the potential for meaningful dividend growth.
- NYSE listing provides daily liquidity.

*Fund currently makes distributions in accordance with a managed distribution plan. As of December 31, 2025, distributions include amounts characterized for federal income tax purposes as ordinary dividends (including qualified dividends), capital gain distributions and estimated nondividend distributions, also known as return of capital distributions. Return of capital distribution may include a return of some or all of the money that an investor invested in Fund shares. With each distribution, the Fund issues a notice to shareholders and a press release containing information about the amount and sources of the distribution and related information. The amounts and sources of distributions are only estimates and are not provided for tax reporting purposes. Fund reports the character of distributions for federal income tax purposes each calendar year on Form 1099-DIV. In recent years, a significant portion of the Fund's distributions has been characterized as return of capital. The Fund's distributions in any period may be more or less than the net return earned by the Fund on its investments, and therefore should not be used as a measure of performance or confused with "yield" or "income." Distributions in excess of Fund returns will cause its NAV to erode. Investors should not draw any conclusions about a Fund's investment performance from the amount of its distribution or from the terms of its managed distribution plan. The Fund's distributions are determined by the investment adviser based on its current assessment of the Fund's long-term return potential. As portfolio and market conditions change the rate of distributions paid by the Fund could change.

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


